Prior to the commencement of season 2008 the Women's Standing Committee forwarded a recommendation to remove promotion and relegation from the 2008 Women's Rules of Competition.


The rationale for this recommendation was to provide the Women's Standing Committee time to canvas all Senior Women's clubs on how best to structure the women's competition.

After extensive discussions the following will take effect for season 2009:

- The Club finishing in 11<sup>th</sup> position at the end of the Women's **Premier League** season will be relegated to the Women's State League **Division 1** in season 2009.
- There will be no promotion from Women's State League **Division 1** in season 2009.
- The Club finishing in 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> position at the end of the Women's **State League 1** season will be relegated to the Women's State League **Division 2** in season 2009.
